THINGS TO BRING

On a typical camp day, you will be dressed in jeans or shorts, T-shirt, athletic socks, and tennis shoes. Campers will not have access to laundry facilities. We will provide **2 camp T-shirts**, but you will need shirts for the rest of the week. You can use a laundry marker to mark all clothing and personal belongings before coming to camp, if you wish. Please bring only one suitcase, a sleeping bag and a pillow, as storage is limited.

Clothing List

- 4 pairs of shorts (no writing on backside please)
- 4 short-sleeved shirts (no visible undergarments or midriff please)
- 1 pair of long pants
- 1 long-sleeved shirt or sweatshirt
- Sleepwear
- 5-6 sets of underwear and socks
- Swimsuit (**one-piece swimsuits**)
- 2 pairs of shoes - 1 pair of athletic shoes and 1 pair water shoes/sandals for water activities
- Hat
- 1 light rain jacket
- Special outfit for camp dance (no visible undergarments, mini-skirts, or low cut tops please)
Theme: Royalty [think crown, tiara, scepter, royal robes, costume jewelry, etc to look royal]
- One set of older clothes for activities potentially ending in a nasty mess

Sleeping gear & Towels

- One sleeping bag/blankets (cots are provided, but no bedding)
- Pillow (if desired, none are provided)
- 2-3 towels and washcloths, including swimming towel

Personal Items

- Bible, notebook, and pen or pencil
- Plastic garbage bags for dirty laundry
- Toiletries - hairbrush, comb, toothpaste, toothbrush, deodorant, soap, shampoo, sunscreen, etc.
- Shower shoes or flip-flops
- Sunglasses
- Insect repellent
- Flashlight with NEW batteries
- Medication (if needed)
- Camera and film (optional - recommend disposable with your name on it)
- Snack food and water (optional)

Do NOT Bring:

- Valuables such as expensive jewelry, watches or rings, excessive money
- Handheld games, portable radios/CD/DVD/ipods or any other electronic device
- Cell phones

Should you bring these items, they may be collected by counselors and returned on the last day.

If you are old enough to drive and plan to leave your vehicle on camp property during the week, you will need to turn in your keys to Aaron Frim after unpacking on Sunday afternoon. You will be able to retrieve your keys from him on Friday before you leave.
